### **Cigar Lounge**

Gentlemen are encouraged to wear blazers, dress shirts, tailored trousers, and leather footwear.

Ladies are encouraged to wear elegant evening attire and refined footwear.

Athletic or pool attire is not permitted.

### **Formal Dining & Dining Hall**

After 7:00 PM, elevated evening attire is strongly encouraged.

Gentlemen are encouraged to wear jackets or blazers with dress shoes.

Ladies are encouraged to wear elegant dresses or sophisticated evening attire.

Sportswear, pool attire, and excessively casual clothing are not permitted.

### **Open-Air Dining & Terrace Areas**

Smart luxury casual attire, refined resort wear, and elegant summer dressing are encouraged.

Presentation should remain polished and tasteful.

### **Not Permitted**

The following are not considered suitable within the Club premises:

- Torn or distressed denim
- Excessively casual or revealing attire
- Caps or hats inside formal dining spaces
- Rubber slippers, sandals flip-flops

- Clothing with oversized logos, political messaging, or offensive graphics

### **Grooming & Presentation**

Members and guests are expected to maintain refined grooming standards, including neat appearance, proper hygiene, and polished presentation.
